Registration payments are **non-refundable**.

Payment reserves the camper’s spot.

Registration and payment is not available for individual days at a prorated rate.

No Early Bird or Extended Day available.

If your camper is on a NFC swim team and will be attending practice in the mornings, you must make other arrangements for your child to be picked up.

No child may be left unsupervised between swim team practice and Camp Nottingham.

All campers must be picked up at 2:00 by a parent or adult designee.

No campers will be left to their own devices after camp.

In consideration for all campers, Camp Nottingham strictly enforces a no-Nit policy.
